## DVRUpgrade® Kit Installation Instructions Series3 TCD648 Add-On Drive Kit



**WARNING. Do not attempt to attach your Add-On drive kit to a unit that has already been upgraded. These kits are expected to only work with Series3 TCD648 models which have not been modified with larger hard drives.**

Installation of your DVRUpgrade Series3 add-on drive kit could not be more simple. Just follow the instructions below and you will be up and running in no time at all.

Step 1: Power down your unit. Rather than just disconnecting your power cord, we recommend you do the following. Press the TiVo button and proceed to *Messages & Settings --> Restart or Reset System --> Restart the TiVo Digital Media Recorder*, and confirm the action as prompted. Once the system is restarting, unplug the power cord or disconnect the power source from your unit. Now you have safely shut down your unit.

Step 2: Unpack the components of your Series3 add-on drive kit and simply connect the included eSATA cable to the TiVo DVR, and the hard drive enclosure.

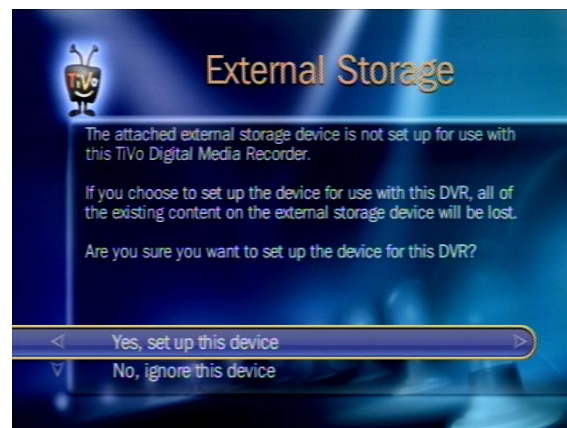
Step 3: Now, connect the eSATA enclosure to a power source, and once all of your equipment is situated where you want it, go ahead and turn the power to your eSATA device ON.

Step 4: After five or more seconds, go ahead and apply power to your Series3 unit, it should boot up as normal.

Step 5: Once your unit has booted, press the TiVo button on your remote a few times. You should eventually be prompted with an important message indicating that an external storage device has been detected. If you do not see such a message, your drive may not be connected properly or may not have been powered on when the TiVo rebooted. Back up to Step 3 and try again.



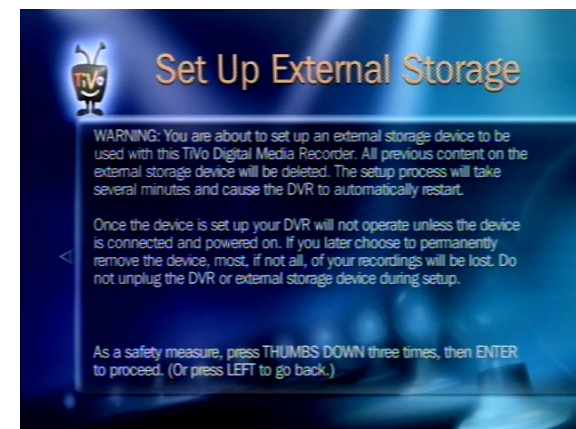
Step 6: Answer "Yes" to set up the external storage device that has been detected.



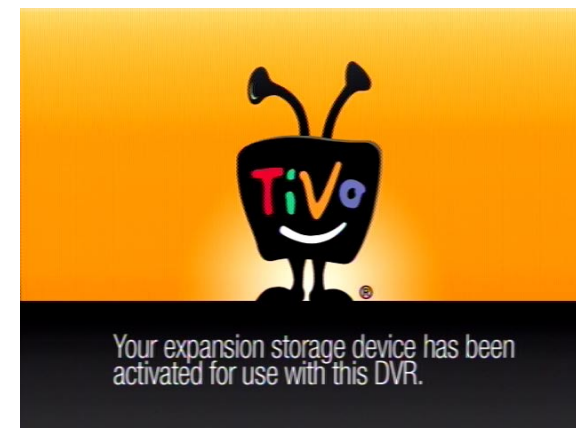
Step 7: Confirm that you are OK to set up this device for use with your TiVo Series3 DVR. Note that if you had any content on the drive from a previous setup with a different Series3 DVR, the information on the drive will be lost.



Step 8: Since the device you are adding is unsupported by TiVo, you will receive another warning. Just answer "Yes" to confirm that you want to set up the unsupported device.



Step 9: And finally, after several minutes, and a reboot of your DVR, you will see the following message, indicating success.



You are now done with the installation and as soon as that screen goes away, you can continue using your TiVo as you normally would. You can verify the new capacity of your unit from the system information screen or the recording quality settings menu on your unit.
